REPORT ON

PROCUREMENT OF SANITARY TOWELS AND KNICKERS FOR 32 GIRLS ENROLLED IN PRIMARY FIVE, SIX AND SEVEN OF KATWE PRIMARY SCHOOL LOCATED IN NSAMBYA AREA ONE OF THE SUBURBS OF KAMPALA CITY

1.0 Introduction

TURGET UGANDA requested Global Giving based in the United States of America to fundraise for procurement of 1000 sanitary towels for girls who are enrolled in upper primary school (Primary five, Primary six and Primary seven) and are living in the suburbs of Kampala City-Uganda. Procurement of sanitary towels and knickers for 1000 girls enrolled in upper primary schools in Kampala City Suburbs was one of the planned activities under TURGET UGANDA Menstrual Health Management in Kampala City Suburbs Project.

TURGET UGANDA Menstrual Health Management in Kampala City Suburbs Project main aim is project is to eliminate stigma resulting from women's natural process of monthly menstruation. The project is to eliminate negative cultural beliefs associated with women natural body growth, development and rights. Its specific objective is to procure 1000 sanitary towels for girls enrolled in upper primary school living in suburbs of Kampala city manage their monthly flows with dignity.

Global Giving was able to mobilize One Hundred and ten (110) United States Dollars. After deduction of management costs Global giving was able to transfer ninety five (95) United States Dollars taxes to TURGET UGANDA. TURGET UGANDA used the funds to procure sanitary towels and knickers for 32 girls of Katwe Primary School located in Nsambya Area one of the suburbs of Kampala City.

This report is made for Global Giving- USA. Procurement of sanitary towels and knickers for 32 girls of Katwe Primary School was done and delivered to pupils on 5th of April, 2018. TURGET UGANDA team was led by Executive Director (Mrs. Barbara Grace Kiconco) and conducted menstrual health sensitization activity among pupils from Primary five, six and seven of Katwe Primary School located in Nsambya Area one of the suburbs of Kampala City.

On 5th of April, TURGET UGANDA sensitized 32 girls, 40 boys and 7 teachers of Katwe Primary School. After the sensitization 32 girls were provided by a knickers, and packet of sanitary pad.
